Fishy Restrictions

New restrictions on the fishing industry off the coast of Maine state any fishing vessels must keep at a minimum three-mile distance from any offshore facilities, including the Outpost Horizons.

With these new restrictions the fishing industry of Cutler Falls and surrounding towns may take a brutal hit as it drastically reduces possible fishing locations. Furthermore, it will increase travel time to get to appropriate fishing waters as vessels will have to traverse around the facilities

Anyone caught breaking these new rules is subject to the revocation of their fishing license and may even have their vessel impounded.
